

Assisted Living Added to Two SLC Chicago Communities

CHICAGO (June 26, 2009) – Chicago-based Senior Lifestyle Corporation announces the addition of assisted-living services at two of its existing Chicago communities, Autumn Green at Midway Village and Autumn Green at Wright Campus. To meet increasing demand, the communities will be licensed to provide assisted-living services to approximately 26 apartments at each location. The communities received final approval from the Illinois Department of Public Health on Thursday, June 25.

Opened in 2005 and 2007 respectively, Autumn Green at Midway Village and Autumn Green at Wright Campus currently offer, and will continue to offer, independent-living apartments and condominiums. Anticipating the potential need to evolve with the changing requirements and demands of its residents, the buildings were designed to accommodate the addition of licensed assisted living with relative ease. The specific renovations were completed to meet all state requirements while enhancing the environment to serve the assisted-living residents. Each community also added Licensed Practical Nurses (LPNs) and licensed caregivers to its staff to accommodate the personalized care needs of the residents in the assisted living apartments on a 24-hour basis.

Autumn Green nursing staff will work in tandem with residents, their family members, and physicians to develop a personalized care plan based on specific needs and preferences. As the needs of a resident change, the care plan will be adjusted and updated regularly to provide appropriate services.

Autumn Green at Midway Village features 126 apartments at 6700 S. Keating Avenue (67th Street and Cicero Avenue) in Chicago. Autumn Green at Wright Campus is located at 4239 N. Oak Park Avenue and offers 133 rental apartments. Each community also includes newly constructed, for-sale condominiums that provide owners with access to all of the amenities and services on campus on an a la carte basis. Both campuses are staffed 24 hours a day and include more than 25,000 square feet of park-like open space and more than 10,000 square feet of common amenities, including a generously appointed dining room; social lounge; library; fitness center; media room; and computer lab.
